<b>Author fees</b>	No fees	
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<b>Supplementary materials</b>	Can include supplementary materials	
	Supplementary materials are available online	
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	Pros	Cons
<b>Author fees</b>		<b>\$25</b> for traditional publishing (restricted access)
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<b>Royalties / profits</b>	Author may receive modest royalties for traditional publishing	ProQuest/UMI profits from licensing and sales of dissertations, including dissertations published open access
<b>Access options</b>	Immediate open access	Some publishers consider an open access dissertation to be a prior publication
	Delayed (embargoed) open access	
	Restricted access (traditional publishing) – only users with licensed access to the UMI database	
<b>Supplementary materials</b>	Can include supplementary materials	Supplementary materials are not available online; available on CD or DVD only with purchase of print dissertation
<b>Discovery</b>	Discover in the ProQuest <a href="#">Dissertations &amp; Theses Global</a> database (access restricted to users at licensing institutions)	
	Option to discover in an Internet search (e.g., Google)	
<b>Preservation</b>	Long-term preservation and access	
<b>Re-use rights</b>		Cannot license re-use rights
<b>Usage reports</b>		Only royalty reports for traditional publishing
